RECENT DISTRESSED TRANSACTIONS AND RESTRUCTURING PROCEEDINGS

- Counsel to Antarctica Capital in its successful stalking horse bid acquisition via dip credit bid of the Geosys / Earth Daily divisions of UrtheCast Corp. The CCAA proceedings were commenced in the BC Supreme Court and involved a multi-jurisdictional acquisition including Chapter 15 proceedings in the US Bankruptcy Court for the District of Minnesota, *redressement judiciaire* proceedings in Toulouse, France, in addition to coordinating acquisitions of related divisions in Switzerland, Australia and Brazil.
