> MT>Ventures and the DMZ Partner to **Launch Startup Legal Support Program**

In the spring, MT>Ventures and the DMZ launched the award winning Startup Legal Support program ("SLS"). SLS is a legal clinic designed to provide Canadian tech entrepreneurs with access to free, comprehensive legal services, and strategic advice. Startups in SLS can save on legal services and still build companies on a solid legal foundation.

The SLS partners with students at the Lincoln Alexander School of Law to give future lawyers the opportunity for hands on training while providing invaluable legal support to early-stage tech founders.

MT>Ventures oversees law students as they provide legal direction to early-stage founders in areas such as Corporate and Commercial, Employment, and Intellectual Property Law. Service offerings include review of:

- employment contracts,
- terms of service and privacy policies,
- shareholder and founder agreements,
- sales contracts.
- articles of incorporation, and
- · confidentiality agreements

Startups in the SLS program have access to legal strategy sessions where law students help founders assess their legal needs. Through a series of events and 1:1 sessions with law students and MT>Ventures, SLS provides founders with the resources they need to understand their legal assets and liabilities. SLS is available to founders in the DMZ's **Incubator Program and Black Innovation** Program. MT>Ventures also works with the DMZ SLS staff to provide a variety of legal programming to the DMZ founders.

The DMZ and MT>Ventures were recognized by **Precedent Magazine in** the fall as one of four **Precedent Innovation** Award winners.








MT>Ventures Stacked


